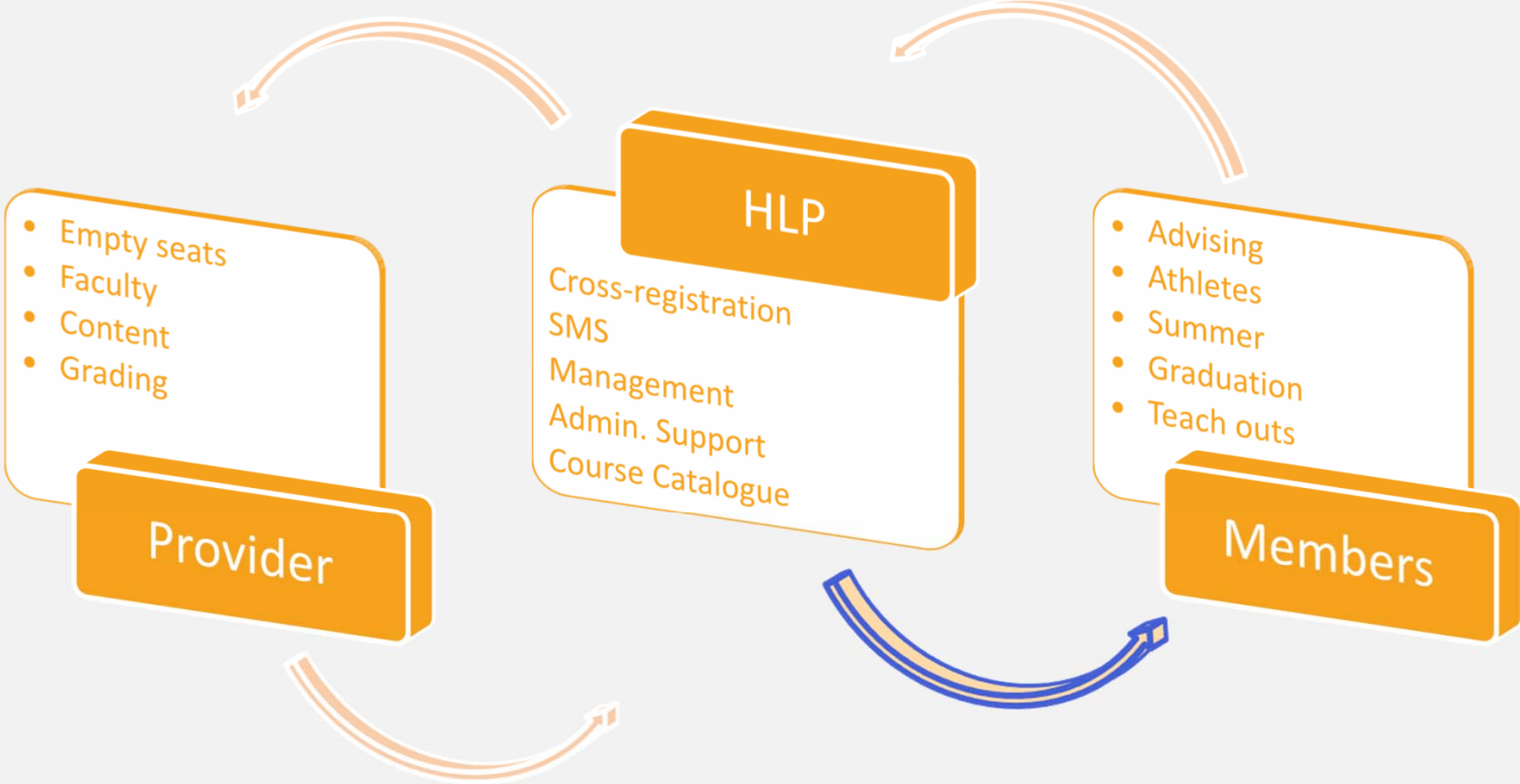

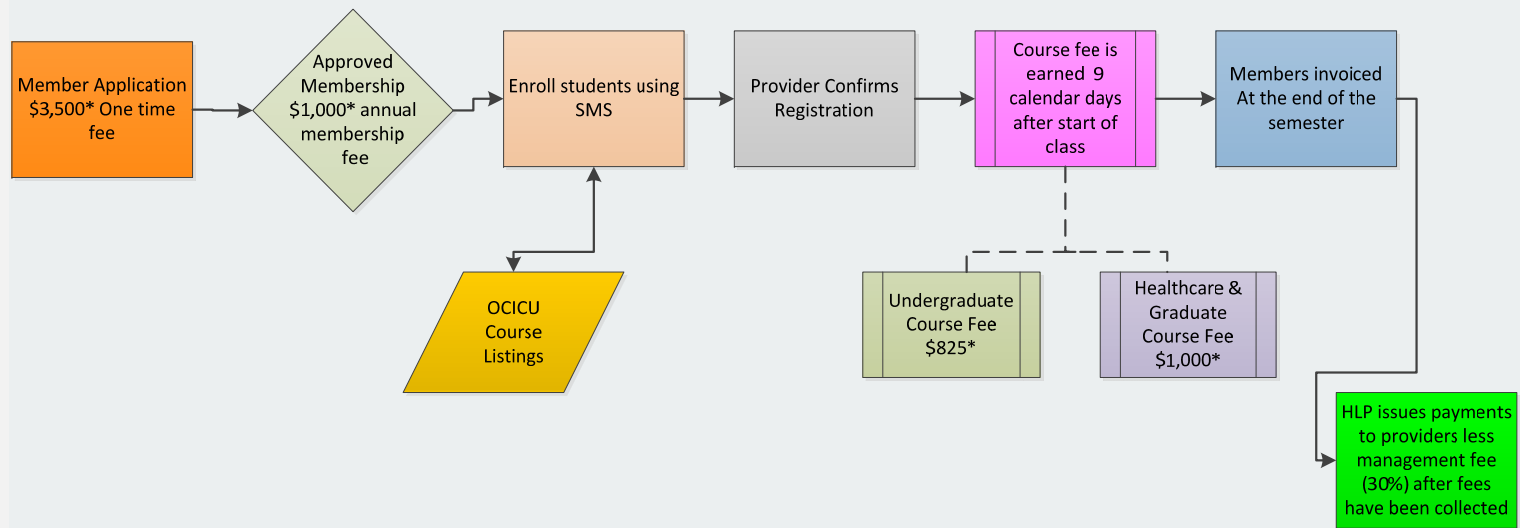


MAP TO SUCCESS



REVENUE SHARING/ REGISTRATION FLOW – FALL, 2017

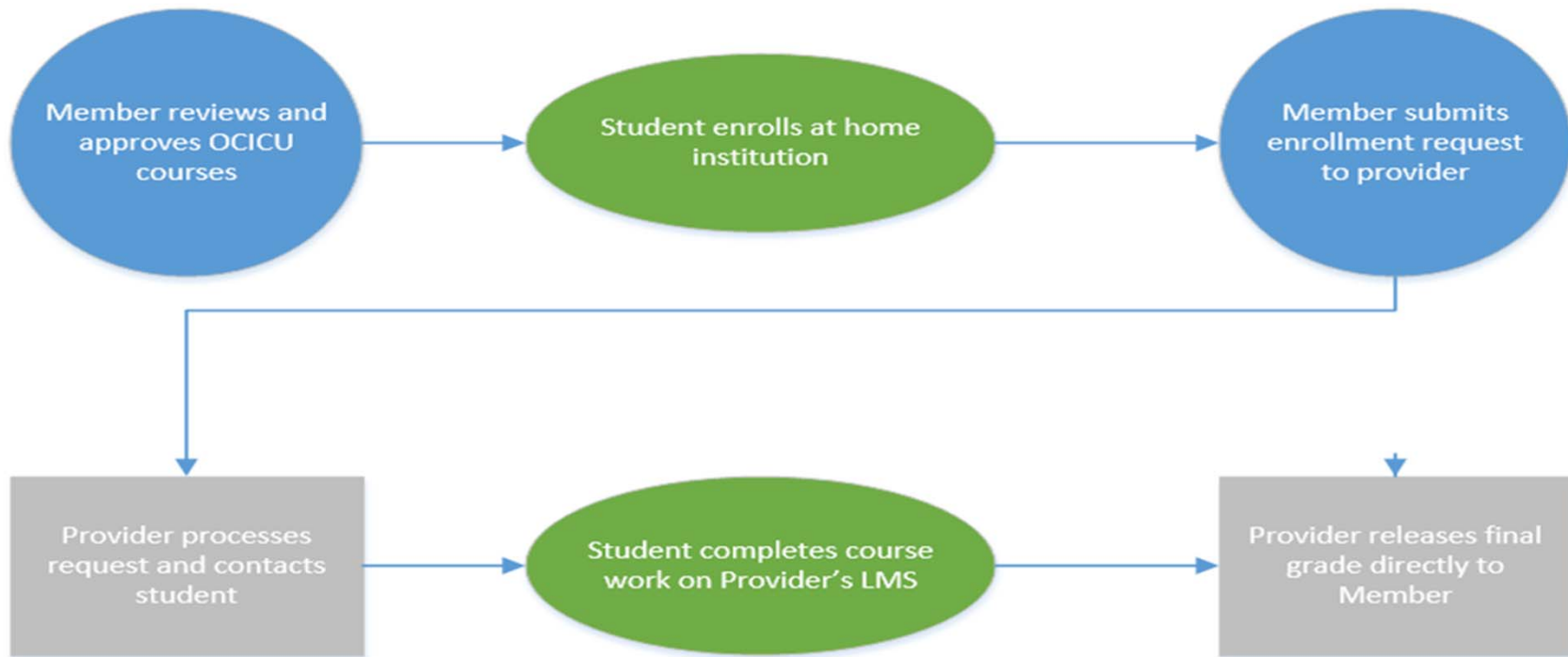
General membership, enrollment, and pricing flowchart

- Online academic and student services support organization for Florida's public colleges and universities.
- Created in July 2012 by Section 1006.73, F.S.
 - Consolidated four separate entities into FLVC.
 - Achieved comprehensive, single point of access to online services.
- Joint oversight by the Chancellors of the State University System and the Florida College System.

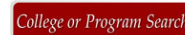
